

Quinta GeneracionThe youngest wine from Dehesa de los Canonigos

Dehesa de los Canonigos Quinta Generacion 2013 is a full-bodied wine, where fruitness prevails over wood, aimed at a younger crowd who may be new to wine and whose tastes are dominated by the desire for fresher flavours and bouquet.

Picked from a single 20 year-old vineyard, known as "El caserio", the result is this contemporary wine, the expression of the finest raw material and a well-pronounced fruitness, providing a certain complexity and demonstraing the true taste of the tempranillo grape.

A young wine, with a hearty soul, full of expression on the nose and lively in the mouth.

Production: 30.000 bottles (0.75l)

Varietal composition: 100% Tempranillo

Barrel ageing: 4 months in medium toasted, fine-grained American

oak barrels.

Tasting Notes:

Cherry red with a hint of purple, an initial fruitness in the nose, which leads, little by little, to suggestions of liquorice and balsam, giving way to an expressive array of fruit which spreads through the mouth like fresh silk with noble balance.
